

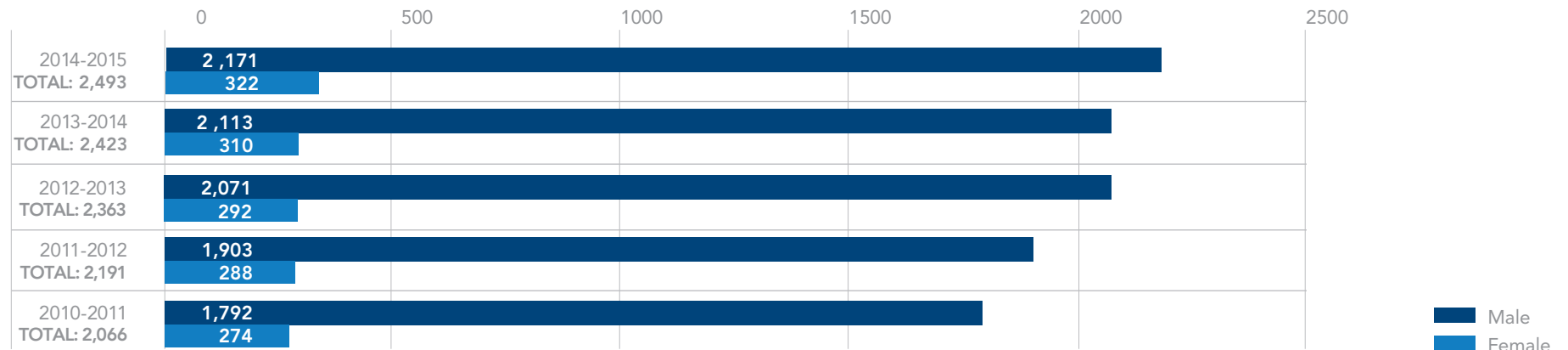

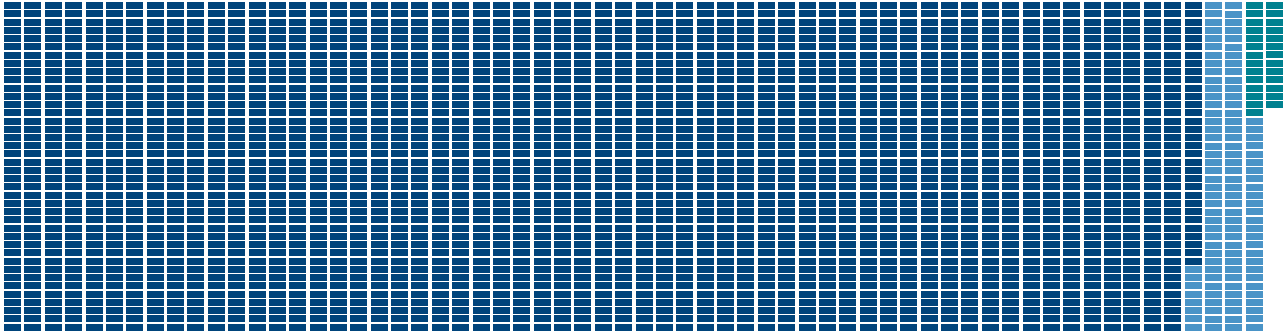

## Undergraduate Student Headcount Enrollment by Gender

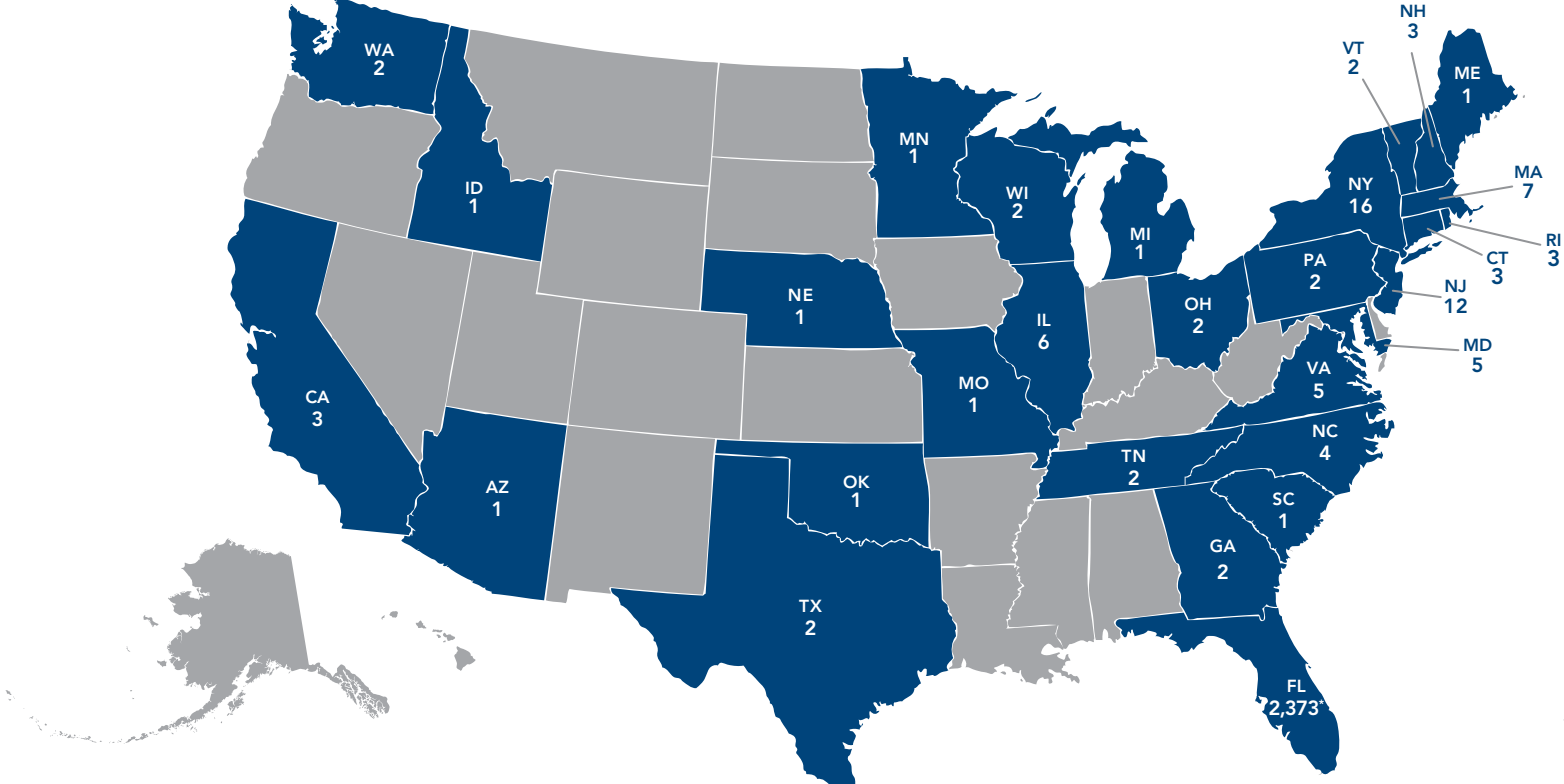
